

### English Grammar: Active and passive voice

**The passive voice** in English is formed with the verb to be and the past participle, which is different for regular verbs (translated, showed) and irregular verbs (taken, thrown).

Tense	Passive
Present simple	The car is repaired
Present continuous	The car is being repaired
Past simple	The car was repaired
Past continuous	The car was being repaired

**Statement:** The letter is written. This shop was opened.

**Question:** Is the letter written? Was the shop opened?

**Negative:** The letter is not written. The shop was not opened.

#### Use

The passive voice is used:

1. If the action is more important than the agent. The important thing is what happened, not who did it.  
A demonstration has been held. This theatre was built in 1868.  
The important thing is what happened, not who did it.
2. If the agent is not known.  
He was offered a job. (Someone offered him the job)

#### Exercise 1:
